Important Notice Regarding GDPR & Business Studies Mailing List

You are receiving this email as you are currently subscribed to our JCT Business Studies mailing list. As you may be aware under the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), new EU rules surrounding Data Protection will come into effect on the 25th May 2018. As a result, Junior Cycle for Teachers (JCT) are required to ensure that all data held must be fairly obtained and processed.

To this end we are now requesting that if you wish for your contact details to be included on the JCT Business Studies mailing list you will need to re-subscribe. To continue hearing from JCT Business Studies about our supports for teachers please re-subscribe using this link.

Latest date for completion of Subject Learning and Assessment Review and for award of final descriptors by the teacher	Friday 21st December 2018




Level 2 Learning Programmes

The team have produced a document focusing on potential links between the Level 2 Learning Programmes (L2LPs), Priority Learning Units (PLUs) and the Business Studies Specification. This is intended to support teachers in linking with the Specification and planning for Level 2 Learning Programme students. The document is available in the planning section of our website.

Feedback on Draft JCSP Business Studies Statements

The draft JCSP Statements for Business Studies have been prepared by our colleagues in PDST. These draft statements have been developed with input from a number of practicing Business Studies teachers in JCSP schools. Business Studies Sample Questions



Our colleagues in the NCCA have developed <u>a set of sample</u> <u>questions</u> which offer a broad indication of types and formats of assessment items that might be used to assess the learning outcomes in the Junior Cycle Business Studies specification at a common level. The items included should be read as examples of individual pieces of assessment material.

They are not full or partial questions from an examination paper, neither do they attempt to replicate how the examination paper might be laid out but you may find them useful to support the development of assessment material, in particular as we approach the end of the final term for first and second year Business Studies students.
