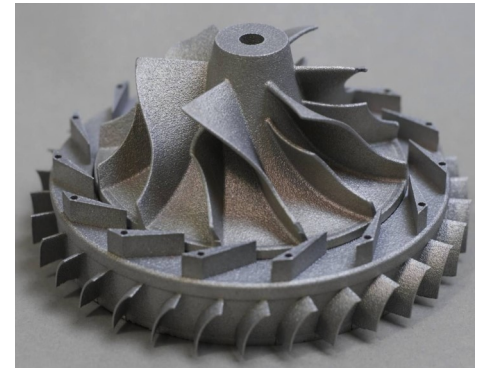
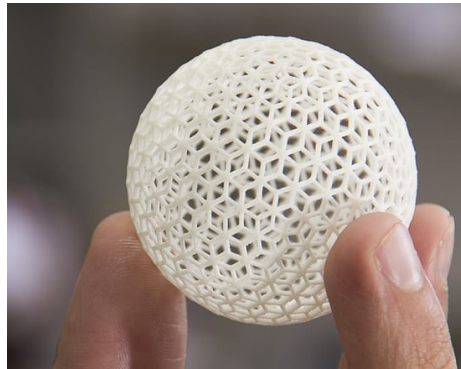
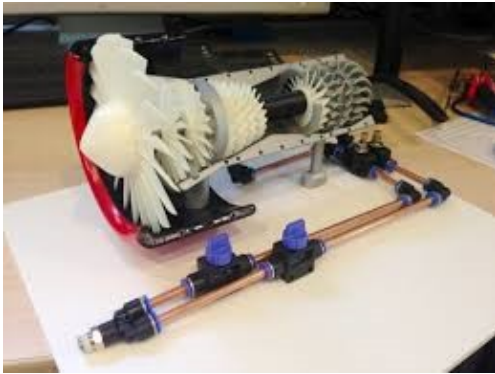


# 3D Printing in the Classroom - Creativity and Design
