L1LPs & L2LPs

Priority Learning Units

The L1LPs and L2LPs build on prior learning but are essentially designed around Priority Learning Units (PLUs) that focus on the social, personal and prevocational skills that prepare students for further study and life. There are 5 PLUs at 2; Communication & Literacy, Level Numeracy, Living in the Community, Personal Care and Preparing for Work. PLUs There are 6 at Level 1: Communication, Language & Literacy, Numeracy, Personal Care & Wellbeing, Being part of a Community, The Arts and Physical Education.

Each priority learning unit is a cross curricular unit of learning. To ensure students are engaging with a broad and balanced curriculum, they should engage with all 5 PLUs at Level 2 and 6 PLUs at Level 1. Dependent on the identified individual strengths and needs of each student, they should engage with the PLUs through as many Junior Cycle subjects as possible.




Useful Free Online Resources

It is a free website with a range of maths activities for all levels of mathematical ability. There are worksheets covering a range of maths topics and seasonally themed worksheets such as these St. Patrick's Day worksheets.

This activity below involves counting leprechaun hats totalling up to 10. Whereas other activities are more difficult such as one involving plotting points on four coordinate quadrants plane to draw α shamrock. The availability of these free tiered levels of worksheets may be useful to teachers of junior cycle students following the L1LPs, L2LPs and mathematics.
