Changes to Classroom Based Assessments: Current 3<sup>rd</sup> Years:

Each student must complete only **one** CBA in each **subject** rather than the usual two in each subject. **One** CBA in each short course continues as normal.

This cohort of students will not be required to complete Assessment Tasks.

Assessment of Oral Communication is key. Therefore, where students are studying Irish and Modern Foreign Languages they must Complete:

CBA 2: Communicative Task in Irish

CBA 1: Oral Communication in Modern Foreign Languages

Students studying Visual Art, Home Economics, and Music must complete CBA 2
