Instrument Group	Learning Outcome	Description
Flute (Fl), Clarinet (Cl), Bassoon (Fg)	Creating & Exploring	Develops students' understanding of how music is created through experimenting, improvising, understanding and searching.
Cornet (Cor), Trombone (Tbn), Euphonium (Euph)	Participating & Music Making	Students perform as a method of demonstrating their understanding of music through communicating, fluency, technical control, rehearsing, revising, refining and interpreting.
Violin (Vl), Viola (Vla), Violoncello (Vc)	Appraising & Responding	Develops students' aural skills of analysis, comparison and evaluation of music through critiquing, reproducing, justifying opinions, informing decisions, expressing feelings and refining performances.
