# **Graphics Specification**

Thirty years after its introduction in 1989, the Junior Certificate Technical Graphics syllabus will be replaced by the Junior Cycle Graphics specification. In September 2019 the Junior Cycle Graphics specification will go live in post-primary classrooms across Ireland for incoming first year students.
